- 1898: Land purchased for school.
- 1901: Onehunga Primary School built costing £2374 and £60 for the belfry.
- 1980: Community retains building for community use.
- 1982: Building becomes Onehunga Community House
- 2018: Building restored. Category A Unitary Plan Auckland Council.
- 2019: Category One Historic Building
