- **1898:** Land purchased for school.
- **1901:** Onehunga Primary School built costing £2374 and £60 for the belfry.
- **1980:** Community retains building for community use.
- **1982:** Building becomes Onehunga Community House
- **2018:** Building restored. Category A Unitary Plan Auckland Council.
- **2019:** Category One Historic Building
